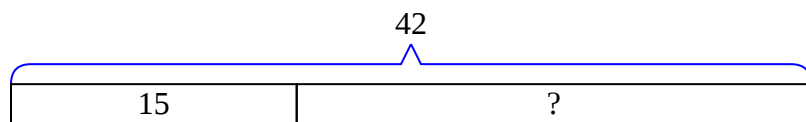
- 1) A clown had 42 balloons. He gave 15 away at a party. How many balloons would he have left over?
